**REGULAR AGENDA**

**1) Weather Camera/System Proposal**

Fundraising underway, \$1500 raised thus far. Hughes is contacting LifeFlight and the Chamber of Commerce to seek more local funding. The Idaho Aviation Association has committed to help get to the full system cost. Hughes will inquire if businesses to have advertising on the weather website. There is support for adding a third camera to face the northwest amongst the Commission. Powers will source the 4 inch pole to mount the weather sensor. Hughes will file the FAA Form 7460 to get approval to mount the weather system near the parking ramp.

**2) Airport Maintenance Items**

Hughes replaced the light in the bathroom with a flat LED light and Pederson fixed the security light outside the bathroom. Powers will add hooks to the aircraft tiedowns to make them easier to install and remove. The corkboard for the kiosk will be installed when the weather warms up. A suggestion has been made to refresh the supplies in the bathroom for stranded pilots.

**3) Summer 2022 Activity**

A September 10, 2022 activity at the airport has been proposed. Wings and Wheels theme with old cars and fly-in, food trucks and an airport open house. This will be raised with the Airport Manager for coordination.

**4) Draft Hangar Lease Template**

A draft hangar lease template was drafted, reviewed by the Commission and is pending review by the Council City Attorney, J-U-B and the Airport Manager to ensure it meets compliance requirements

**5) Airport Entrance Sign**

It is proposed a sign be design and proposed to the Airport Manager to hang on the entrance to the airport off airport road. Hughes offered to donate the cost of having the sign made.

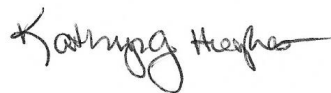
**6) Airport Articles**
