

CITY OF COUNCIL SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

WORK HOURS: City crews are on call 24 hours a day during snow removal months, November 15th through March 15th.

ACCUMULATION: Accumulation of snow on paved streets within the City of Council will not exceed 6 inches before snow removal commences.

DEADLINE FOR OPERATIONS: All streets within the City of Council will be plowed after or in between storms completely within a 1 or 2 day time frame.

PRIORITIES: The following list of streets has been prioritized for the start of snow removal:

- a. Business District - Illinois Avenue
- b. School – Bleeker Avenue
- c. City Hall & Business Park
- d. All other streets & avenues
- e. Airport

PARKING RESTRICTIONS: (ref. Ordinance #314)

- a. No Parking on the south side of Illinois Avenue from Galena Street to Michigan Street.
- b. No parking on Streets between 2 am. through 6 am.
- c. No abandoned vehicles on streets or in alleys.
- d. Vehicles, RVs and camp trailers must be 10 feet off edge of pavement.

DRIVEWAY BERMS: Berming is an inconvenient result of plowing. Adjacent property owners are responsible for clearing the berm to gain access to the roadway. Qualified disabled full time residents registered annually with City Hall will be placed on a berm removal list. This is a courtesy offered only after all priority routes are completed and if time allows.
